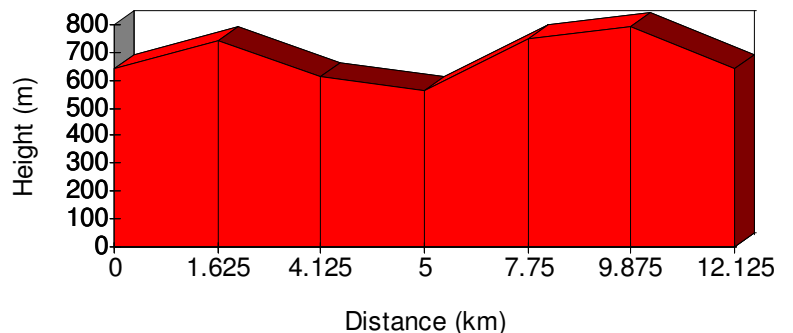


Route Two – “Fun for All”

This tracks ventures through the overwhelming shadow of the Canigou, it's a trail for all the family holding something for everyone. The slow opening uphill should give you a gentle warm up and give an idea of the forthcoming day's riding. We leave the main road just past the bridge descending onto a large open fire track which has fast sections but with clever use of brakes you can attack the track as fast as you like for a big adrenaline rush or as cautiously as you feel safe.

During the breathtaking downhill don't forget to take a look over to your left to catch a great view of Vernet, if to take a snap of where you're staying or just to regain your breath! At the junction there is the option to take a single track walkers' route or the fire track down into Corneilla.

When arriving in Corneilla, you have another energy sapping uphill to look forward to on the old road to Fillols. Along the way you have old trees overhanging the road which give you that much needed shade when climbing in the middle hours of the day, and just to keep your mind occupied on the way up there are some great views of the Canigou to take in.

Fillols is a great place for a much needed pit stop, with a good lunch menu if needed or cold drink in the quaint little café which also has a great patio so you can sit out in the shade and take in the local culture. From Fillols you have an easy journey up and over the Col de St Eusebe and down into Vernet via road.
